Health-care compliance is a fairly new industry, developed out of the government’s crackdown on Medicare fraud. Compliance professionals assure that health-care providers follow federal, state, and local regulations that govern the delivery of health care.

The Healthcare Compliance Certification Board was founded in 1998. It develops criteria to determine competence in the practice of health-care compliance and recognizes individuals who meet those criteria.



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
