

## Co-Payments

Some services require co-payments from you. This means that you need to pay a fee to the office that gives you those services.

As of July 1, 2006, here are the services that need co-payments from you, with the amount for each payment:

- Doctor Office Visits: \$2
- Emergency-Room Visits: \$3 (if not an emergency)
- Hospital Outpatient Visits: \$1
- First Day of Hospital Inpatient Stays: \$50 per stay
  
- Vision: \$2 per visit  
\$2 per frames or lenses
  
- Podiatry: \$2 per visit
- Chiropractic: \$1 per visit
- Hearing Aids: \$3 per aid
  
- Pharmacy: \$3 for name brands of drugs  
\$1 for generic brands of drugs

Co-payments are not for members younger than 21 years. There are no co-payments for family-planning products or services or for any pregnancy-related products or services.

Please pay your doctor's office, hospital, or pharmacy. Do not mail or take your payments to the Upper Peninsula Health Plan.
