Pharmacy Formulary Available Through Epocrates® References

The Upper Peninsula Health Plan's (UPHP's) pharmacy formulary for Medicaid and MIChild members is now available through Epocrates® drug-reference software at www.epocrates.com. You can access it via your computer or download the Epocrates drug database to your personal digital assistant (PDA) handheld device. The Epocrates Rx software is available free for Palm and Pocket PC handheld PDA devices. Premium versions with alternative medicines, clinical tables, and medical calculators are available for an annual fee.

Once you access or download the database, you can check formulary status, prior authorization requirements, formulary alternatives, generic substitutes, and quantity limits. The software also features a drug reference with such information as indication, dosing, contraindications, drug interactions, adverse reactions, and cost.

If you already use an Epocrates product, you can add UPHP's formulary by going to www.epocrates.com and clicking on *Add Formularies* in the page's top right corner. Log in with your user name and password. Select *Upper Peninsula Health Plan* (under *Health Plans* and *Michigan*), followed by *Add*, and then *Save*. Press your *Hotsync* ("AutoUpdate") button (while connected to the Internet) to download the formulary to your PDA device. "AutoUpdate" (automatically update) frequently to get updates from UPHP and Epocrates.

If you do not currently use an Epocrates reference, you need to download the software to your PDA device to access the UPHP formulary. Go to www.epocrates.com, and select the version of the software you prefer. Epocrates Rx (drug and formulary reference) is free.
