



## HEALTHY KIDS DENTAL

You or your child has dental benefits through the **Healthy Kids Dental** plan when one of you is an Upper Peninsula Health Plan (UPHP) Medicaid member younger than 21 years. The Healthy Kids Dental benefits come from Delta Dental rather than UPHP.

To get this dental care, you need to find a dentist who treats patients with Healthy Kids Dental. To find a dentist:

- Call dentists in your area and ask if they participate with Healthy Kids Dental.
