



Appointment Scheduling Guide

<p>Well Baby Exams Quality measure requires: <u>Six</u> visits by 15 months of age</p>	<p>Schedule visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 2-3 days after discharge ➤ One month ➤ Two months ➤ Four months ➤ Six months ➤ Nine months with developmental screen ➤ Twelve months ➤ Fifteen months ➤ Eighteen months with developmental and autism screen ➤ Twenty-four months with autism screen ➤ Thirty months with developmental screen <p>Can schedule with illness focused exam as long as sufficient time to complete all components of well care exam.</p>
<p>Well Care Exams All members 2- 21 years of age</p>	<p>Schedule <u>annual</u> well care exam any time during each calendar year</p> <p>Does not have to be 365 days since last exam</p> <p>Can schedule with illness focused exam as long as sufficient time to complete all components of well care exam.</p>
<p>Follow Up Care for Children Prescribed Medication for Attention – Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder</p>	<p>Schedule visit <u>within 30 days</u> of when ADHD medication is started for the first time. <i>Best practice only give 2-3 weeks worth of medication and assess prior to 30 days</i></p> <p>Schedule children who stay on ADHD medication for <u>two more visits between 31 days - 9 months</u> of starting medication – one of these can be a phone visit</p>
<p>Cervical Cancer Screening Women 21 to 64 years of age</p>	<p>Schedule for a routine Pap test at least every <u>3 years</u></p>
<p>Prenatal Care</p>	<p>Schedule for prenatal visit in <u>first trimester</u> or <u>within 42 days</u> of enrollment in UPHP</p>
<p>Postpartum Care</p>	<p>Schedule postpartum visit <u>on or between 21 to 56 days after delivery</u></p>
<p>BMI Assessment Nutrition and Physical Activity Counseling</p>	<p>Schedule a BMI assessment to be completed as part of every <u>initial visit of the year</u>, for every patient <u>2 years of age</u> and older. All patients 2 years and older should have a BMI assessment, counseling for nutrition and counseling for physical activity.</p>
