

**MI Health Link Claims**

Upper Peninsula Health Plan (UPHP) MI Health Link members have both Medicare and Medicaid coverage. For dually processed claims in which Medicare’s reimbursement exceeds the maximum allowable by Medicaid, the Medicaid claim line will pay zero.

- If the Explanation of Payment (EOP) shows “\$0.00” in the *Payment* column with an *Explanation Code* of *PMA (PRIMARY PAID MORE THAN MEDICAID ALLOWABLE)*, this claim is considered “paid in full”.
- If there is an amount in the *Payment* column or the *Co-Insurance* column of the EOP with an *Explanation Code* of *P209 (CANNOT COLLECT FROM PATIENT)*, this claim is considered “paid in full”. The provider may not balance bill the member.
