Medicaid Pregnant Women Dental Notification

Pregnant Women Dental (PWD) will become effective July 1, 2018. This means that pregnant women on UPHP Medicaid will have dental benefits. PWD is a limited benefit and members are covered only for the duration of their pregnancy, as well as the three-month period following the due date. Members are provided a Pregnant Women Dental specific Delta Dental ID card. Pregnant members will be able to see dentists that are contracted as part of the Delta Dental provider network. Members may also receive transportation to and from scheduled dental appointments.
