



2019 UPHP Provider Value-Based Payment Program (VBP)

What is VBP?

A program that rewards UPHP network providers for attaining targeted practice transformation and service goals such as specific health care quality or efficiency standards. Annually, UPHP reviews the needs of its members, federal and state requirements, and provider performance data to evaluate its current VBP incentives and determine future incentives.

What are the 2019 Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) VBP Measures?

For 2019 care, the following measures will be used for VBP incentives to provider practices:

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Chlamydia Screening Incentive

In an effort to improve chlamydia screening rates, UPHP will pay providers \$15.00 for each chlamydia test claim received during calendar year 2019 meeting incentive criteria. Payment will be distributed in the beginning of 2020.

Chlamydia Screening	Medicaid MIHealth Link	Providers will be paid \$15.00 for each chlamydia test claim received during calendar year 2019 for UPHP women aged 16-24 years (one incentive payment per member) based on HEDIS measure eligibility, assigned PCP, and laboratory CPT codes.

All care must be completed per HEDIS and Michigan Department of Health & Human Services Guidelines. For more information, contact Teresa Mager in the UPHP Clinical Services Department at 906-225-7952.

- Payment will be based on achieving the HEDIS National Medicaid Benchmarks: 75th, 90th or, if below the 75th percentile, statistically significant improvement. Developmental screening payment will be based on MDHHS benchmarks.
