

Clinic Billing Guidance

Per guidance received from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), effective for date of service (DOS) Jan. 1, 2022, the following providers are permitted to be reported in the attending field (FL 76) for institutional invoices submitted by FQHCs, RHCs, Tribal FQHCs and THCs:

- Physicians (including podiatrists, optometrists, and chiropractors)
- Nurse Practitioners and Physician Assistants
- Certified Nurse Midwives
- Clinical Psychologists
- Clinical Social Workers
- Clinical Nurse Specialists
- Licensed Psychologists (Doctoral Level)
- Social Workers (Master's Level)
- Professional Counselors (Master's or Doctoral Level)
- Marriage and Family Therapists
- Limited Licensed Psychologists (Master's or Doctoral Level)

Upper Peninsula Health Plan (UPHP) will accept the attending providers listed above on the institutional format for the impacted clinic types beginning with DOS on and after Jan. 1, 2022.

Covid-19 Billing Updates:

Per guidance received from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), the COVID-19 Fee Schedule has been updated with coverage of three additional codes representing the Pfizer Pediatric COVID-19 vaccine and administration:

- 91307 – Sarscov2 Vac 10 Mcg Trs-Sucr
- 0071A – Adm Sarscv2 10mcg Trs-Sucr 1
- 0072A – Adm Sarscv2 10mcg Trs-Sucr 2

Coverage of these codes became effective Oct. 29, 2021.

Consistent with Medicaid guidelines, providers seeking reimbursement for COVID-19 vaccine administration services must be registered in CHAMPS. In addition to CHAMPS, providers must be registered in the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) and the MDHHS Division of Immunization's COVID-19 Vaccination Program. Per guidance received from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), UPHP wanted to remind providers that UPHP will pay for the COVID-19 vaccine and its administration (including approved booster doses), without cost sharing, beginning Jan. 1, 2022. This will be for beneficiaries enrolled in the Medicare Advantage plan.
