

Important Medicaid Notice Regarding Opioid Point-of-Sale Edits

Effective July 1, 2021

In alignment with Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), the allowed cumulative daily morphine milligram equivalent (MME) will be lowered to 90 MME. The current cumulative limit is 120 MME.

- The MME edit is applicable to:
 - UPHP Medicaid
 - UPHP Healthy Michigan Plan
 - UPHP Children's Special Health Care Services
- Quantity limits and prior authorization requirements could apply.
- The MME edit will NOT apply to members that have cancer-related pain, are in hospice care, or reside in a long-term care setting.
- Claims with cumulative prescribing over 90 MME without a prior authorization will reject.
- Prescribers with members currently being prescribed above the 90 MME will be contacted.
- Opioid naïve edits will still apply.
