

Revised 2020 Value-based Payment (VBP) Measures and Immunization Incentive

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on clinic services, UPHP has changed the CY2020 Value Based Payment (VBP) metrics and added an incentive payment to match the vaccine administration fee for immunizations provided to children 0-36 months of age.

- Value-Based Payment is a program that rewards UPHP providers, complying with the terms of the Network Provider Participation Agreement, for attaining targeted practice transformation goals such as specific health care quality or efficiency standards. Annually, UPHP reviews the needs of its members, federal and state requirements, and provider performance data to evaluate its current VBP incentives and determine future incentives.
- *Controlling Blood Pressure and Comprehensive Diabetes Care: BP control (<140/90 mm Hg)* payment will be made for achieving either the 75th or 90th HEDIS National Medicaid Benchmark.
- VBP measures and payments are subject to change without prior notice.

Childhood Immunization Status	Medicaid	UPHP will match the MDHHS Medicaid vaccination administration fee for all recommended immunizations given to UPHP members age 0-36 months from 7/1/2020-12/31/2020	Paid in the first quarter of 2021
